We are also pleased to announce that the **SV650 Cup** will remain as an official support class for the Parts Canada Canadian Superbike Championship Series. While the “support class” in the National Series will be a Pro/Am event, amateur racers will continue to enjoy the excitement of SV650 racing at CMRA, ASM, RACE, EMRA, AMCRA and WMCR regional events across Canada this coming season.

Suzuki Canada Inc. will be supporting the class with the following prize money based on finishing results as provided by the sanctioning body to Suzuki Canada.

REGIONAL RACES

1st = \$200.00, 2nd = \$150.00, 3rd = \$100.00, 4th = \$75.00, 5th = \$50.00

Six series champions – Each series winner will receive a championship award of \$500.00 at the end of the season and a SV Cup.

NATIONAL RACES (Regional payouts are not available at National events)

1st = \$300.00, 2nd = \$250.00, 3rd = \$200.00, 4th = \$150.00, 5th = \$100.00

National SV Cup Champion will receive \$1000.00 and a SV Cup.

The attached SV650 Cup rules will apply at all events. For further rule information, licensing requirements and other contingency awards for the SV650 Cup contact the racing organization in your region.

2005 SUZUKI SV650 CUP RULES

Suzuki SV650 Cup motorcycles must meet the following requirements in addition to the requirements in Equipment Standards-General. The units must be Canadian spec SV650S Suzuki motorcycles. The modifications listed in this section are the only ones permitted. No other changes from show room stock will be allowed. Older models may be updated with Suzuki Genuine Parts found on a newer version of the same model.

Note: The SV650 Cup Regional Races have been designated as an amateur class only. SV Cup champions are not allowed to contest the series again.

1. Suzuki SV650 Cup motorcycles must meet the requirements of Lightweight Sportbike Equipment except as noted:
 - a) The exhaust system may be replaced with commercially available aftermarket exhaust systems meeting mandatory track noise limits.
 - b) The rear shock may be replaced with an after-market shock.
 - c) Front forks must remain stock. Internal springs, valving, and oil may be changed with any aftermarket components.
 - d) All riders must race on the same brand of tires. For 2005 the spec tire will be Pirelli. The Pirelli Super Corsa 120/70ZR17TL SC1 (Super Soft) Front and the Pirelli Super Corsa 160/60ZR17TL SC2 (Soft) Rear for dry weather and the Dragon Rain 120/70R-17 SCR1 (Super Soft) Front, 160/55R-17 SCR1 (Super Soft) rear for wet weather conditions.
 - e) Steel braided brake lines may be used to replace stock lines. Calipers and rotors must remain stock. (After market brake pads are acceptable.)
 - f) Horsepower limit: 75hp measured at the rear wheel (Sanctioning body to enforce if required).
 - g) **Suzuki** & series sponsor decals must be displayed on prominent parts of the motorcycle.
 - h) Genuine Suzuki SV650S or aftermarket replica bodywork can be used.
 - i) Starters, alternators, air boxes, carburetors and EFI must remain stock and functional, however carburetor jetting or EFI may be adjusted.

Note: Competitors that plan on competing in the National Pro/Am SV650 Cup races will need to make sure their bikes meet the additional requirements for that class which is primarily the need for a “lower catch fairing” or “belly pan” under the engine.
