- iii) There must be a minimum of 8 pro racers starting a race for the race for the race to qualify for contingency payouts.
- iv) In the case of dual sanctioned events, the rider will be paid for one event only.
- v) All claims for 2005 road race contingency must be received at YMCA no later than November 30, 2005
- vi) Yamaha will pay contingency upon confirmation from the race promoter or sanctioning body of the race results.
- vii) Professional racers will be paid by cheque.
