



CHAMPIONS RIDE RED 2005 HONDA ROAD RACE CONTINGENCY PROGRAM

Riding Red wins championships. For 2005, in addition to the National Parts Canada Series support, Honda Canada Inc. will reward racers competing on Honda CBR's, VTR's, and RC51's who win ASM, RACE, CMRA, AMCRA, WMRC, MRA, and EMRA Regional Championships. Regional Championship bonuses up to \$1,500 will be credited to the sponsoring Honda dealer for their races.

Eligible Provincial ASM, RACE, CMRA, AMCRA, WMRC, MRA, EMRA classes:

- Pro Superbike/Open Sportbike
- 600cc Pro
- Pro Hwt/Mwt Twins
- Expert Woman's Cup Challenge – Superstock/Sportbike

- Amateur Superbike/Open Sportbike
- 600cc Amateur
- Amateur Hwt/Mwt Twins
- Novice Woman's Cup Challenge – Superstock/Sportbike

- To be eligible for contingency awards, racers must pre-register with Honda Canada Inc. through a sponsoring dealer by April 30, 2005. Honda Canada reserves the right to use the racers names, results, and photos in advertising without compensation to the dealer or to the racer.

- Eligible racers must have a valid competition licence and be registered with the Champions Rid Red Program.

- Racers must compete for the entire 2005 season on a 2004 or 2005 Honda CBR600F4i, CBR600RR, CBR1000RR, VTR1000F, or VTR100S (RC51).

- Contingency funds will only be credited to your open parts account after receiving a complete Honda Race Contingency Championship Claim Form and official series results as proof of performance for your sponsored racer(s) accomplishment. Claims must be postmarked within 30-days following the end of an eligible championship series. Dealers are entirely responsible for claim submission and the distribution of contingency funds to registered racers.

- Honda Canada Inc. will only pay contingencies in the specified sanctioning bodies and classes for events contested within the program period.

- Honda Canada Inc. reserves the right to amend or terminate the 2005 "Champions Ride Red" contingency program without notice or obligation.
