## AGENDA ITEMS

**1) AIRBAG VESTS** Airbag Vest requirement for the EMRA - Great to have but not available enough to make it a requirement. EMRA rider equipment technical requirements are the highest of any club racing.

**2) RACE SCHOOL # OF GROUPS** Two Groups for Race School if it sells out – Not doing a second race school. Limit is increased to 45 this year, with 37 already registered for race school.

**3) NOVICE PROMOTIONS** Moving Novices Up – Complete 4 rounds clean and deemed component to get promoted. Currently works that way.

**4) NUMBER CHANGES** Single Numbers – Removing intermediate single numbers. Not interested in making change.

**5) EMRA WEBSITE** Changes to Website – Update link to Track Attack Castrol website. Link under new rider, rider info. Castrol needs to add EMRA membership requirement to their site.

**6) MSR TEXTS** Communication Via Text Msgs. From Motorsports registration – Only major delays, other race delays on race days, and lunch times changes. Will try it out this season.

2-Stroke Rules – The 2-stroke limit is ½ the 4-stroke limit in the rule book. Let those asking run whatever 2-stroke they would like. Rule book to be changed to remove 2-stroke displacement limits.

Class Changes – Class changes for lightweight/middleweight bike classes. AGM is time for such discussions. No discussion of changes entertained.

**7) REVIEW BIKE SHOW** Review of Bike Show – Positive reviews of the bike show. Attendance 24,017 slightly down from last year. Request to promote the flat track more. Another give away that isn't a race school? No agreement for change. For social media give away we could do only a hashtag#.
