3. COVID-19 Update

a) Alberta Health Services – Progress on Green Light Operations: Jon has been doing his best to get the green light from AHS to run our events. Will keep trying. We will plan to run our first Race Round May 29/30 as usual. Wait to see what the provincial update is effective May 25 before officially cancelling.

Motion: Vote to Proceed with Race Round 1 until May 25 when Provincial Covid Restrictions are announced if they are to the contrary.

- b) Rapid Covid Testing: May be able to get 2200 rapid covid testing with Mahikan Medical. Perhaps that will help with getting AHS approval.
- c) Race Rounds: A reminder that any race rounds cancelled/do not proceed on the date(s) scheduled will not be rescheduled and will stay cancelled. The schedule stays as is.

4. Race School

We will need to postpone race school as we do not have approval from Alberta Health Services to run our event. It will be rescheduled to July 16 - 17, 2021 at Stratotech Park.

5. Motorheads Track Attack Race School

In light of EMRA's Race School being cancelled and rescheduled after Race Round 2, if Motorheads Track Attacks wishes to run their own Race School on their June 12, 2021 date, would the EMRA consider the training good and sufficient for race license purposes for that date only? Doing this would allow for more novice riders to participate in Race Round 2 (June 26/27). Motorheads Track Attacks would have to abide by EMRA Race School curriculum and testing if they choose to do so. Costs and track time is completely up to Motorheads Track Attacks.

c) E-Transfers – Still no luck with the bank being able to set this up. Scott will have to keep trying to work with bank.
