1. Called to order at 7:12pm.
2. Reviewed action items (refer to Table 1 on page 4).
3. Finalized rule book
 - a. Determine list of exclusions for supermotos from Lightweight SBK
 - i. Exec agreed to the following update to line 2 of Lightweight SBK rules:
Twin and Single cylinder, 4-stroke motorcycles up to 440cc
 - b. 600 classes to match CSBK rules (CSBK rule book does not permit GSZX-R750, but they have been allowing them to race against 600s. Even found cases where a 750 won the race and would have been subject to park ferme scrutiny.)
 - i. Exec agreed to the following wording:
The maximum displacements (O.E. bore and stroke in all instances) are:
 - a) Four cylinder: 600cc (Kawasaki ZX-6R 636 accepted)
 - b) Twins: 1000cc
 - c) Triples: 900cc
 - d) Exception that the GSX-R750 is also permitted
 - e) Bikes qualifying under rule b), c), d) must run stock model year final drive gearing.

Secretary’s note: While updating the rulebook with this information it became clear that that the wording in bullet e) would restrict more bikes than was intended (e.g. Triumph 675 triple, FZ-07 twin). To rectify this issue bullet e) was re-written to the following and approved via electronic communication with the executive board:

- e) Bikes exceeding the following displacement limits must run stock final drive gearing for the model year.
- i) Four cylinder: 640cc
 - ii) Twins: 850cc
 - iii) Triples: 680cc

4. Bylaws update
 - a. Changes made as per AGM approved.
 - b. Need to revert changes that were not discussed at the AGM to posted bylaws.



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5. Confirm race fees for 2025

- a. Membership and License \$40, \$50
- b. First race, additional races \$100, \$30
- c. Novice races \$100 Includes both novice races for the one day
- d. Airfence deposit \$200

Racers must volunteer twice (will receive \$100 refund after each instance) including at least 1 teardown to get full refund

- e. Gate fee \$10
- f. Racer all access pass \$70
- g. Medical data carrier \$5
- h. Transponder rental fees \$50 for novice, \$75 for int/expert
 - i. Vote by executive to approve fee schedule: 11 in favor, 0 opposed
- i. Membership and license registration to open January 10, 2025

6. Race school, info required to open registration

- a. Price
 - i. Proposal to increase race school to \$450 and this includes first round of novice races (2 races) in the year that you took race school.
 - ii. Vote by executive to approve race school price: 11 in favor, 0 opposed
 - iii. As per previous years this includes membership. Does not include race license or air fence deposit.
- b. Location
 - i. Track Stratotech
 - ii. Classroom Western Canadian Fire and First Aid
- c. Schedule
 - i. Classroom May 16 4:30pm – 9:30pm
 - ii. Track May 17 riders meeting 7:30am – 4:30pm
- d. Sponsor Turple Brothers – to be confirmed by Brian Worsdall
- e. Race school registration to open January 10, 2025

7. Executive task list

- a. Reviewed and assigned executive tasks for the following task groups:
 - i. Monthly and annual tasks
 - ii. Pre-season tasks
 - iii. Airfence tasks
 - iv. Race school tasks



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8. Nima Nassirian's request to "re-vote my suspension"
 - a. Nima arrived at the meeting to attend. He was informed by the Secretary that he was not permitted to attend because he resigned his membership in November. After being refused attendance, he interrupted the meeting by aggressively banging on the meeting room window and yelling curse words directed at the Secretary. The Vice President stepped outside to reason with him, and he left. Nima returned shortly thereafter and once again interrupted the meeting by aggressively banging on the window, yelling, and harassing individual members. This included calling insults about exec members and calling out the names of peoples' children. Despite closing the blinds, this continued for several minutes. He then set off the building security alarm by banging on the window. The Vice President had to deal with the building owners to prevent the police from responding to a false alarm break in. The Vice President and a General Director stepped outside to reason with him and explain the disturbance he was causing before he finally left.
 - b. Bylaws section 3.9 paragraph 2 allows the board to refuse to admit any applicant membership
 - i. Motion made to refuse a membership to Nima Nassirian for 2025. Vote by executive to pass motion: 9 in favor, 0 opposed, 2 abstained due to conflict of interest.
 - c. *Following the meeting the exec discussed Nima's actions further. Policy and Procedure Manual section 6(e) allows the board to establish someone as a vexatious individual, and section 6(e)(iii) further allows the board to ban such an individual from all EMRA events. The board agreed by electronic vote that Nima Nassirian is not permitted at any EMRA events in 2025.*
 - i. *Motion was proposed in executive group communication that Nima Nassirian is not permitted to attend any EMRA events in 2025. Vote by executive to pass motion: 9 in favor, 0 opposed, 2 abstained due to conflict of interest.*
9. Brian shared information about the YEG Motorcycle show happening April 10-13. To be discussed in more detail at future exec meetings.
10. Next meeting to be held February 18th at 7pm.
